LICENSE REVIEW COMMITTEE MINUTES
August 19, 2020

The regular meeting of the License Review Committee for the City of Monona was called to order by Chairman Wood at 4:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Doug Wood, John Klinzing, Joe Forward, Jill Mueller, and Wayne Kimmell

Also Present: Community Resource Officer Nathan Reynolds, Robert Webster and Manager Ryan Driessen from Speedway – Royal Avenue, and City Clerk Joan Andrusz

ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion by Mr. Klinzing, seconded by Ms. Mueller to approve the minutes of the June 9, 2020 License Review Committee meeting, was carried.

APPEARANCES and UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There were no Appearances or Unfinished Business.

NEW BUSINESS

Chair Wood explained the review process to those in attendance. City Clerk Andrusz collected Mr. Webster's signature on his application form. Community Resource Officer Reynolds provided information on Mr. Webster's Operator's License application, reporting there were three open charges relating to child abuse. Mr. Webster responded the charges against him are false and he is fighting them. He thinks that resolution of cases has been delayed by COVID-19. The disorderly conduct charge stemmed from him intervening in a fight in his yard. He recently moved from Texas to Madison to get a new life and be closer to his children and family. The Beacon is only where he gets his mail; he is homeless and stays at various friends' houses.

Mr. Driessen provided information on Mr. Webster's work hours, positive performance in his short time employed, and need for an Operator's License. A manager is almost always present and there are multiple cameras throughout the store. Community Resource Officer Reynolds reported he has issues with this Speedway location and this manager following up with him; his request for video from a disturbance call last week has not been fulfilled. Mr. Driessen responded he thought Officer Reynolds was "short" with him so is gathering information to respond.

Members discussed Mr. Webster's case, asked questions, reminding him he has to fill out applications in full and that the City needs to be able to contact him. Mr. Webster provided information and stated he can be reached at the store.

A motion by Mr. Klinzing, seconded by Mr. Kimmell to approve the 2020/2021 Operator License Application For Robert J. Webster, 615 South Washington Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, because the charges do not substantially relate to his job duties, was carried. Ms. Mueller and Chair Wood voted against the motion.

City Clerk Andrusz provided information on Alcohol License Payment/Item Request Letters, as required.

Members discussed Re-Schedule of the September 8 Meeting because it conflicts with a City Council meeting. It will be held, if needed, on September 16 at 4:00 p.m. in the Library Municipal Room. Ms. Mueller reported she will most likely be on maternity leave at that time.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion by Mr. Klinzing, seconded by Mr. Kimmell to adjourn, was carried. (4:34 p.m.)

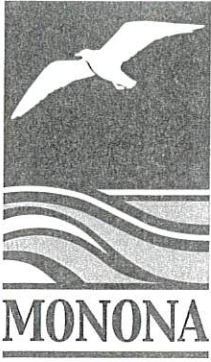
